Why EQAVET-4-INCLUSION is important

Reducing the number of early school leaving has always been a priority. Dropout rates in Vocational Education and Training (VET) are high throughout most countries and a long research on potential reasons. The European Commission believes that the phenomenon of early school leaving by young people is the main risk factor in case of unemployment, social exclusion and poverty

The Project

The project is focused on one the main priority of the Erasmus program; namely Inclusion and diversity in all fields of education by promoting social inclusion of people with fewer opportunities. To achieve it, the project will develop a self-assessment tool for VET providers to measure the level of their readiness for preventing dropout as a part of their quality monitoring and continuous quality improvement.



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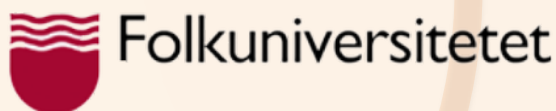
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The project has been launched!
